GOVERNMENT MUST DO MORE THAN RESTRICT BULGARIAN AND ROMANIAN WORKERS

Commenting on the Written Ministerial Statement today by Immigration Minister Phil Woolas that the Government is to retain UK work restrictions for Romanian and Bulgarian nationals, the Co-Chairmen of the Cross Party Group on Balanced Migration said:

"The Government has seen sense and heeded our warnings about the folly of making it easier for Bulgarians and Romanians to come to the UK to compete for work. At a time of rising unemployment, that would have been foolishness. Now the Government needs to act to tighten up other immigration controls, so that foreign workers cannot come here "on spec" to look for work, and also to ensure that all jobs are advertised in the UK first - and cannot be given straight to foreign workers."
